AGREEMENT ON STUDENT EXCHANGE BETWEEN DALIAN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, CHINA AND

YAKUT STATE AGRICULTURE ACADEMY, RUSSIAN FEDERATION

This Agreement on student exchange between Dalian University of Technology (hereinafter referred to as "DUT") and Yakut State Agriculture Academy (hereinafter referred to as "YSAA") will be implemented as follows:

- 1. The exchange students including undergraduate students, master students and doctoral students. The students take the credits based on the course work and/or the research project.
- The fields of student exchange shall be within the areas of Science, Engineering, Architecture, Humanities and Social Science, Management and Economics, to be agreed upon between their departments subject to the provision of this Agreement.
- 3. The home university will select and recommend students to participate in the exchange program. However, the final acceptance of exchange students is always at the discretion of the host university judged by academic performance.
- 4. The exchange students must be enrolled in the home university as regular students and will be exempt from application, matriculation and tuition fees at the host university.
- Each university will have no more than 5 students from the other side enrolled at any time. The actual number of students to be exchanged in a year will be decided each year upon mutual agreement.
- 6. The period of enrollment of the students at the host university should not exceed 12 months. Extension of the period may, in exceptional cases, be permitted by mutual agreement.
- The students will continue as candidates for degrees at their home university and will not be candidates for degrees at the host university.
- 8. The host university will not be liable for travel, living, healthcare, insurance or other expenses incurred by the students. This does not preclude application for scholarships or financial aid from independent institutions.
- 9. The field of study for each student will be subjected to the host university being able to provide appropriate credit-study plans and appoint qualified tutors when required, and provided such credit-study plans are open to exchange students.
- 10. The host university will determine the required language skills for admission in each case, in order to assure that the students have the minimum requirements to carry out his/her studies

successfully.

- 11. The host university agrees to provide, prior to the exchange, the credit-study plan and documentation of course and research work for the students, as well as appropriate documentation about their performance on completion. The home university will determine, prior to the exchange, the appropriate number of credits to be transferred in each case.
- 12. The host university will render assistance to the incoming students in finding appropriate accommodation. The host university will be exempt from this responsibility if the student declines the recommended accommodation.
- 13.Exchange students are subjected to all rules and regulations of the host university. They will also have the rights and privileges enjoyed by other students enrolled at the host university.
- 14. Each university will appoint a contact office and/or person to facilitate the implementation of the program. The appointed officers or persons will act as contact for enquires about the program and will also be responsible for promoting, advertising and overseeing the smooth operation of the program.

The Agreement shall come into effect on the day of approval by both Universities with duration of 5 years. Either University may terminate this Agreement provided that written notice of the intent is given at least six months prior to termination. Commitments already in progress shall be fulfilled.
